The Casa Espanya (Espanya House) was built in the 16th century by the Llunell family. It later became the property of the Molinés and finally the Espanya family.

The purpose of this unit is to preserve and disseminate the cultural and material heritage of L'Hospitalet. The permanent exhibition and educational resources are the main tools for disseminating knowledge on the historical, political and cultural developments in the city from its inception.

\ The Casa Espanya, L'Harmonia and Can Riera buildings make up this museum space with permanent and temporary exhibitions on history, art and democratic memory.
